Health department hosting special clinics for school physicals

The Lexington-Fayette County Health Department is making it easier for parents to get their kids ready for the return to school this fall.

The health department will provide special clinics for school physicals July 19-Sept. 17 for children ages 3 and up. The physicals will be held at the Public Health Clinic South, 2433 Regency Road. Same-day appointments can be made by calling 288-2483. The cost is based according to income. Immunization records need to be brought to the appointment.

All Fayette County kindergarten and sixth-grade students are required to get physicals prior to starting classes.

“We provide this service to help parents who are trying to avoid the back-to-school rush,” said Kevin Hall, LFCHD communications officer. “These same-day appointments will let parents have their children ready for the first day of classes this fall.”
