Health department to host public clinics for seasonal flu shots

A simple, low-cost shot in the arm can help keep Lexington residents healthy throughout flu season this fall and winter.

The Lexington-Fayette County Health Department will begin offering flu shots for adults on Thursday, Sept. 9, at the Public Health Clinic North (805A Newtown Circle) and Public Health Clinic South (2433 Regency Road). No appointment is necessary. Flu shots cost \$25, and Medicaid, Medicare B, cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.

Children's flu shots will be available in mid-September.

The Public Health Clinic North is open 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Thursday; 8 a.m.-7 p.m. Tuesday; and 8 a.m.-1 p.m. Friday. The Public Health Clinic South is open 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Thursday; 8 a.m.-7 p.m. Wednesday; and 8 a.m.-1 p.m. Friday.

The Primary Care Center at 650 Newtown Pike is prepared to make appointments for its regular patients to get their flu shots by calling 288-2307.

In addition to seasonal flu, this year's vaccine will also provide protection against H1N1.
